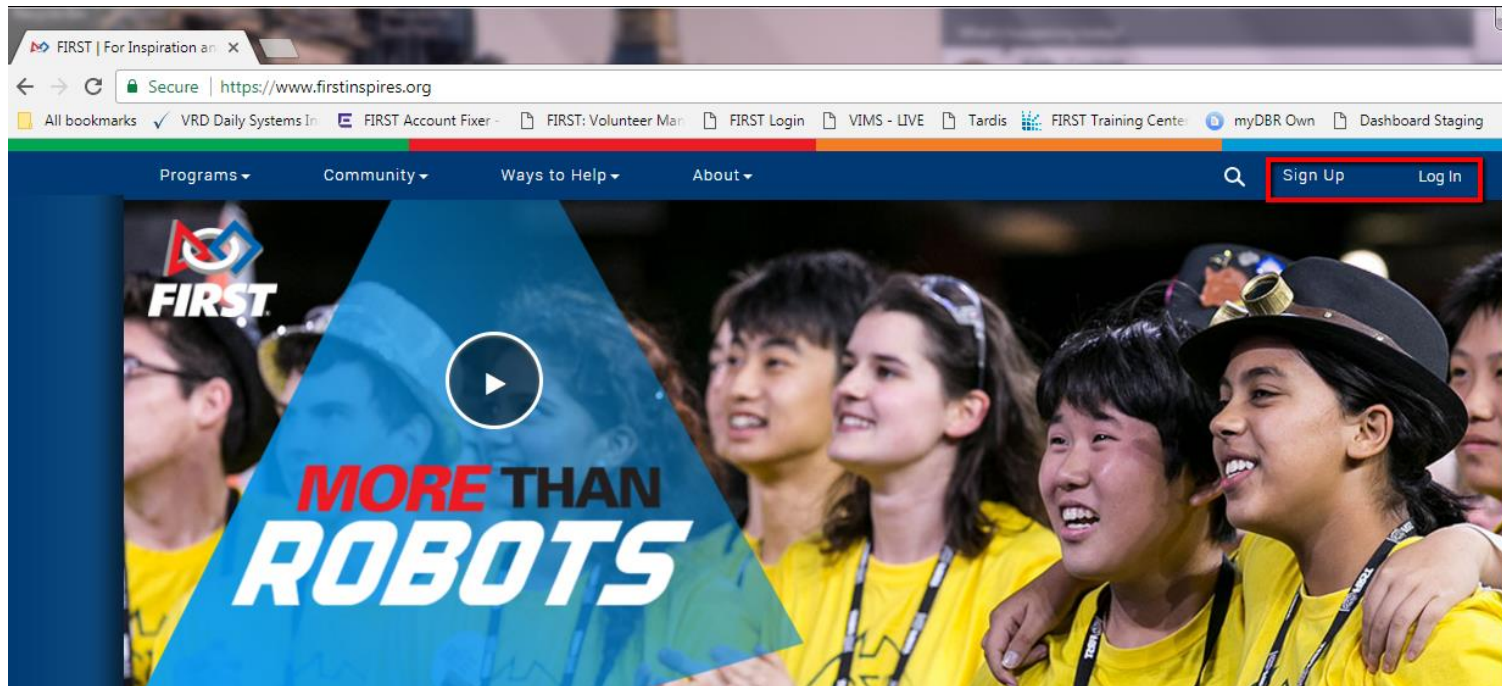





Certifications

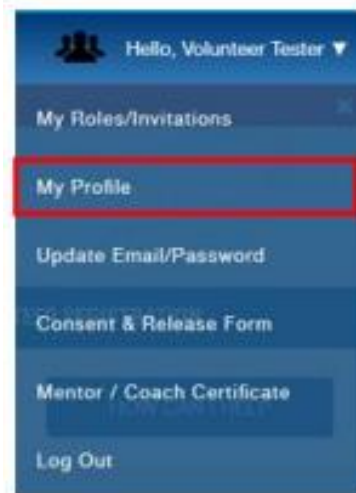
If you are assigned a role requiring certification, click on "Review Outstanding Tasks". Then click the Resolve button, which will bring you directly to BlueVolt to complete your training.
